Sister Daniel Marie Catherine, a member of the Daughters of Our Lady of Mercy, Villa Rossello, Newfield, NJ, went to her eternal rest on December 4, 2016. She died at St. Joseph Parish Convent, York PA where she had lived and ministered with several members of her religious order

Sister Daniel was born in Palmyra, PA and was the daughter of the late Daniel and Erma (Pavone) Catherine. She entered the Congregation of the Daughters of Our Lady of Mercy, in Newfield, NJ on September 8, 1961, and professed her Vows on August 15, 1964.

Returning from the mission, she served as Coordinator of Religious Education at St. Joseph Parish, York for a brief time. From 2008 to 2014, she served as the Provincial Superior of her religious order at Villa Rossello in Newfield, NJ. Her last assignment was at St. Joseph Parish, Dallastown where she was the Parish Evangelist. Sister Daniel was noted for her competency and dedication in whatever area of ministry she worked. She will be missed for her dedication, friendliness to all, love for her community, and for her untiring zeal for ministry.
